- No other set duties exist for this position.
 - This person serves as “grandparent”.
 - This person may take on any duties as they wish.
- As this person is replaced by the next prior President, they automatically become a “Past President” as per Toledo Chapter By-laws.

Requirements for this position:

- Must be a member of the Toledo chapter.
- Have served as prior chapter President.
