The following is a list of duties that the chapter wishes be performed by this position:

- Attend regular BOD meetings. This is a voting position Maintain membership records and report status at board meetings.
- Contact regular members who are late with renewal.
- Keep on record the contact person for corporate memberships and communicate with them when at risk of suspension.
- Personally contact new members, notify the V P Publicity and the web master for inclusion in communications.
- Be a welcoming person at PDMs.
- Attend one or more region conferences each year.
