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President's Message September 2011

Brad Lenhart is the latest member of the Toledo chapter and I'd like to welcome him to the chapter.

I hope everyone is enjoying the tail end of summer, personally speaking I'm glad we saw the long hot spell disappear, this seemed to have been the hottest one of my 11 summers in Ohio and things were cooling down nicely though temperatures have crept back up for the Labor Day weekend. We know in early 2012 we'll all be wishing to get summer warmth back again, we're rarely happy with the weather for long.

In the summer newsletter I mentioned that we had made our CMS and C-BAR submission in mid-July and I was hopeful that by now I would have heard the final decision from the reviewer. Well I did hear back quite recently but not the news for which I was hoping, about a week ago I got a request to resubmit because the reviewer had had a hard drive on his computer crash and he had lost the submission and supporting documentation, fortunately I had my original e-mails with all the attachments (a total of 15 separate documents) and I could resend them.

It's almost a year since the APICS Board decided it would be necessary to establish a more formal contractual agreement between APICS and the North American chapters, over the years APICS had grown from being an American group to one that encompassed North America and then to a more international organization with partners in overseas countries. Although APICS had formal agreements with the partners in overseas countries setting out responsibilities for both sides there was no equivalent with the chapters and the Board was

of the opinion that it was becoming necessary to create that formal arrangement.

They set up a committee with a representative from each of the 9 North American districts, the committee held a number of open meetings, sought feedback from chapters and earlier this year delivered their first draft which was based on the agreements with international partners. Suffice to say it was not accepted with enthusiasm, the feedback was extensive and the committee realized that while chapter officers might see an Agreement as necessary the majority opinion was the version as presented was unacceptable.

The committee went back to the drawing board and around the beginning of June presented a second version, this was based on the Chapter Minimum Standards and met with a much higher level of acceptance, chapter officers again had the opportunity to comment on the proposals and in fact we reviewed them at our District Meeting in June. These proposals were amended in the light of the feedback received then presented to the APICS Board at their July meeting, the Board accepted the proposals and now the work of creating a formal agreement starts. Once the agreement is finalized it will be presented to each chapter and the responsible chapter officer(s) will be asked to sign on behalf of the chapter committing both parties to certain performance standards. The Toledo board are of the opinion these newer proposals are more realistic and assuming there are no major changes from the proposals submitted to the APICS Board would be prepared to sign the agreement, I'll keep you advised of developments.

Education Report – September 2011

I'd like to start by congratulating 2 Toledo chapter members who recently completed APICS certifications:

Jeff Eloff achieved CSCP (Certified Supply Chain Professional) on August 6th

Tony Meo achieved CPIM (Certified in Production and Inventory Management) on August 15th

It's great to see another 2 chapter members complete APICS certification processes, the chapter now has 10 members with CSCP, 41 with CPIM, 1 with CFPIM (Certified Fellow in Production and Inventory Management) and 4 with CIRIM (Certified in Integrated Resource Management)

Those of you who have completed a number of the CPIM modules or are working on CSCP take heart and continue with your studies.

For those who would like to start the CPIM program we will be offering classroom instruction starting with BSCM at Jackson Community College in November and BSCM in Toledo starting in January.

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If you don't want to take an instructor led CPIM class or you don't want to wait till November or January to get started there are other options available, send me an e-mail and I'll send you a short document describing some of them.

As previously announced we do plan to offer a CSCP class and our intention was to offer the class in the October / November time period which would allow participants to apply for a test in the December / January test window. **However APICS recently announced the CSCP course content is being extensively revised for 2012 to ensure that it remains relevant** and that individuals with the 2011 CSCP material would have to cross reference to 2012

material if they take a test after the April 2012 test window.

Accordingly it seems to make sense that we delay the class until the 2012 material is available. Personally speaking I am disappointed that we won't offer the class in 2011 but the board though it prudent to hold back rather than run a class with material that would provide only 2 opportunities for testing before the content would be updated.

However if there are enough people who would still like to sign up for a class based on the 2011 materials, and we'd need a minimum of 6 participants, we would try to offer a class in October / November, send me an e-mail to let me know you are interested.
