Since the meeting both Sheryl and Brian have been hard at work in their respective areas, Education and Programs, the rest of the team have been reviewing our budget and strategic plan and Lindsay is already planning for this year's CPA and C-BAR submissions.

We hope to build on the Education and Programs successes of last year and that we will see many of the chapter members at our various events during the year.

2012 – 2013 Channel Partner Agreement (CPA) and Chapter Benchmarking and Reporting (C-BAR)

This was the year that The Channel Partner Agreement replaced Chapter Minimum Standards and although there are a number of similarities there were some new requirements with which the chapter had to comply. I am pleased to say that we were fully compliant.





Complying with the CPA requirements allows the chapter to submit for C-BAR, for the last 6 years the chapter has achieved the Gold Award standard and was designated a Platinum Chapter on the fifth year. C-BAR is a self-scored assessment which is then reviewed by a member of the Mid Atlantic District staff, and our score for 2012 – 2013 of 380, if confirmed, will mean that we will be awarded Gold and retain our Platinum designation.

Education Report – August 2013

APICS CPIM Certification Review Classes

A new round of CPIM Certification Review Classes begins Tuesday, September 24, with Module 1, **Basics of Supply Chain Management (BSCM)**. Once again, we plan to offer the classes at The University of Toledo. The tentative schedule for Modules 2 through 5 is as follows:

January/2014 CPIM Master Planning of Resources (8 weeks)
April/2014 CPIM Detailed Scheduling and Planning (9 weeks)
September/2014 CPIM Execution and Control of Operations (8 weeks)
January/2015 CPIM Strategic Management of Resources (8 weeks)

For those who are finishing up the previous round of CPIM Certification Review Classes, classes for Module 5, **Strategic Management of Resources (SMR)**, will begin Wednesday, October 2, and again, we plan to offer the SMR classes at The University of Toledo. SMR is the final, capstone module prior to certification, and it assumes a knowledge of Modules 1 through 4. It is recommended that you take SMR only after having completed the other four modules.
