The 687,000 sq ft facility operates as a closed campus, protecting, tracking, and storing over \$200million in product inventory. The high-security facilities for the pharmaceutical handling systems were reinforced by an integrated architectural and site plan. The Perrysburg distribution center carries 24,000 typical products sold in Walgreens stores in Ohio, Michigan, Indiana and parts of Illinois, Kentucky and Pennsylvania. Our tour will begin promptly at 6:00 pm on September 17th. Check in will begin at 5:30.
