Each team consisted of 4 members, with each member having a specific role in the on-line business game-**The Fresh Connection**. Along with 20 other student teams from Mid-Atlantic, the teams competed in 3 competition rounds to determine the top 5 teams to go forward to the final in February. Unfortunately despite their best efforts neither team placed in the top 5.

Last month we published the new 2016 CSCP Exam Windows as released by APICS, unfortunately there was an error in the starting date for Exam Window #2, it was shown as June 9th but the correct start date is July 9th.

The corrected table is shown below.

July 9, 2016	August 27, 2016	No change to end date	7 weeks
September 3, 2016 (New window)	—	October 15, 2016	6 weeks
October 29, 2016	December 17, 2016	No change to end date	7 weeks

The 2015 version of the CSCP exam will be available for the first three exam windows; the 2016 version of the CSCP exam is available during all 4 windows.

The Toledo chapter will be offering an instructor-led CSCP class starting in September.
