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President's Message

The kids have started back to school, both the universities are back in session, football teams are gearing up, there's a hint of autumn in the air... Yup, Fall is here!! And, APICS Toledo is ready to begin its 2017/2018 calendar of events. Registration is now open for APICS Toledo's Fall certification review courses: [CSCP](#) begins Saturday, October 14th; [NEW CPIM Part 2](#), Thursday, October 19th; and [NEW CPIM Part 1](#), Saturday, October 21st. **Register for any of these classes before September 8th, and take a \$100 early-bird discount!** Act now!!

And, good news, we've re-scheduled the CLTD Certification Review Course!! A number of folks are interested in CLTD, but didn't have enough time to get registered for the September 6th class. So CLTD has been moved, with a new anticipated start-date of mid-late January. Watch for further details!!

Legacy CPIM Update: As of August 31st, exam credits for the Legacy BSCM are no longer available; however, if you need to **retake** the BSCM exam (i.e., you've previously taken the BSCM exam and failed), **retake** exam credits will be available until January 6th. All Legacy BSCM exams must be taken by January 7, 2018. They will no longer be administered after that date.

If you need to complete exams for the other Legacy CPIM modules (SMR, ECO, DSP, MPR), first-time exam credits for those modules will be available until June 30, 2018, and if you need them, you can purchase retake exam credits until December 15, 2018. All Legacy CPIM exams will be completely phased out on December 31st, 2018.

Congratulations are in order for some exam successes over the summer. **Jeremy Riehl** passed SMR, and is now CPIM certified. Jeremy works at Crown Battery in Fremont, and began taking chapter classes in January, 2016. All the hard work has finally paid off. Job well done, Jeremy! **Patrick Andriette** passed ECO. Great job, Patrick! Patrick works at GKN Driveline in Bowling Green, and is preparing for his SMR exam....good luck! Three more candidates have passed the Legacy BSCM, **Jason Brown**, **Dennis Kellermeyer**, and **Monique Willis**. Congratulations to all! Looking forward to seeing you Oct 19th for the NEW CPIM Part 2!!

And, welcome to Patrick Andriette, who has joined APICS Toledo's Board of Directors as VP Education. Sorry to see Matthew Gardner leave the board. Thanks for your service, Matthew! And glad to have Patrick aboard....looking forward to working with you!
