He began his CPIM journey with Basics of Supply Chain Management (BSCM) under the Legacy CPIM system, and because of the reconfigured CPIM, was able to earn his certification with only one additional exam. So Greg is APICS Toledo's first member to earn his certification under the new 2-module system. Well done, Greg!! All the hard work paid off!
