We are excited to be finishing up the first round of private in-house CPIM certification classes at **Johns Manville** in Defiance, Ohio. There are 7 on-site learners from the Defiance facilities, and include employees from production scheduling, quality control, warehousing, customer service, administration, and finance. There are also 7 remote learners from other Johns Manville locations: Edison NJ, Belgrade MT, Winder GA, and Cleburne TX. The remote learners attend the class via WebEx, and represent various positions in Production and Engineering.

The class has just concluded CPIM Part 1, and students have begun studying and reviewing for their CPIM Part 1 exam. The class will resume in January with CPIM Part 2, which runs for 16 weeks. After candidates pass the CPIM Part 2 exam, they will have earned the CPIM designation. Good luck to all! And many thanks to **Jim Swift** for allowing APICS Toledo the opportunity to bring this in-house training to Johns Manville.
